- Objective data on PENT effectiveness, including action plan outcomes and the reduction of office discipline referrals, suspensions, and expulsions within counties (how to link PENT activities to support the Local Control Accountability Plans)
- Examine the racial disproportionality in school discipline, and the use of culturally-relevant PBIS and MTSS practices

 - PENT data management system for shared resources (e.g., Dropbox)
- ✓ ■ Web-based training management system to filter by county and topic
 - Access to the B-POSS online BIP scoring tool

- ✓ ■ Potential continuing education units from the Behavior Analyst Certification Board
