5 minute	<p>Key Elements: All implementers identified and responsibilities specified.</p> <p>Scoring Problems: Failure to specify who is responsible for carrying out what.</p>	<p>Key Elements: Reciprocal two-way communication of data. Must describe between <i>whom</i>, during what <i>conditions</i>, <i>manner</i>, and <i>content</i> of communication regarding FERB.</p> <p>Scoring Problems: Lack of any data, lack of baseline data, does not specify between whom and under what conditions data are communicated, and sought after in-bound communication not specified in two-way communication.</p>
