

CLASSROOM RULES

KEY ELEMENTS

1. The class should be included in the initial rule-making phase.
2. Rules should be brief and to the point.
3. Rules should be stated positively.
4. Attention should be called to rules as often when they are being followed as when they are being broken.
5. Rules should change depending on the situation and activity.
6. Students should be provided with advance notice as to which rules are in effect.
7. Rules should be posted.
